<u>HB 2374</u>	Hill, Brian(R) Thompson, Kristen(R)	Modifies provisions related to the Filmed in Oklahoma Act to expand eligible production types, establish standards for loan-out companies and direct certain economic impact reviews for the program; EMERGENCY.
<u>HB 2768</u>	Caldwell, Trey(R) Hall, Chuck(R)	Increases certain investment amount limits under the Quality Jobs Incentive Leverage Act.
<u>HB 2772</u>	Caldwell, Trey(R) Hall, Chuck(R)	Adjusts standards for the ROADS Act and its related fund, increasing certain limits, removing language related to supplanting funds and designating money for weigh station improvements; EMERGENCY.
<u>HB 2781</u>	Caldwell, Trey(R) Hall, Chuck(R)	Creates the Reindustrialize Oklahoma Act which establishes a system for qualifying parties to apply for economic incentive capital expenditures meeting certain standards.
<u>SB 224</u>	Seifried, Ally(R) Caldwell, Chad(R)	Creates the Education and Workforce Statewide Longitudinal Data System to provide a secure means of analyzing statewide data related to education workforce issues.
<u>SB 249</u>	Thompson, Kristen(R) Townley, Tammy(R)	Extends the sunset date for inducement claims related to the Tourism Development Act.
<u>SB 287</u>	Pugh, Adam(R) Miller, Nicole(R)	Extends the duration of certain aerospace industry employer tax credits and broadens the definition of a qualified employer to include institutions of higher education dedicated to relative research.
<u>SB 578</u>	Coleman, Bill(R) Kelley, Mike (F)(R)	Extends the duration of the Quality Events Incentive program.
<u>SB 987</u>	Thompson, Kristen(R) Osburn, Mike(R)	Creates a Dept. of Commerce Board to manage and conduct various functions and duties of the Dept. of Commerce.
